SPECIALIZATIONS

EM Strasbourg Business School

Students from Bratislava can major in one of the specializations offered to full-time students:

- Finance Accounting (Finance-Comptabilité-Contrôle, Banque-Finance)
- Supply Chain Management (Supply Chain Management, International Purchasing)
- Management (International and European Business, European Management, Entrepreneuriat, Ressources Humaines et Responsabilité Civile des Entreprises)
- Marketing (Marketing Stratégique et Opérationnel, Négociations et Management Commercial, E-marketing et Management des TIC)
- International and European Business

University of Economics in Bratislava

There are no majors, all the study program is devoted International management, but students can choose three courses from three groups of compulsory-optional courses:

- Compulsory-optional course I. (Compensation and stimulation, Development of managerial skills)
- Compulsory-optional course II. (Innovation management, Business consulting)
- Compulsory-optional course III. (Corporate governance, Management of change)

ELIGIBILITY

- Students must hold a Bachelor's degree in Economics/Management/similar disciplines
- Students who have validated the equivalent of 180 ECTS credits
- Students who are enrolled in a Master's program in their home university

LANGUAGE OF INSTRUCTION

French or English - EM Strasbourg Business School
English – University of Economics in Bratislava

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

All requirements set out by the two universities must be fulfilled:

- 120 ECTS credits (60 ECTS credits in each university)
- A Master's thesis, if mandatory
- An internship, if mandatory

TUITION FEES

Tuition fees and other fees are to be paid to the home university.
