SPECIALIZATIONS

Students from the University of Pavia can attend the Master program in Economics offered to full-time students. Depending on the chosen specialization in Pavia, students can chose courses in the fields of: Econometrics, Financial Econometrics, Economics of Innovation, Health Economics, Industrial Organization & Competition Theory, International Trade; Markets and Consumption, Public Economics, Economic History and History of Economic Thought, Environmental Economics, Growth Economics or Money and Employment

Depending on the chosen courses in Hohenheim, students from the University of Hohenheim can choose courses in one of the specializations offered to full-time students in Master of MEFI:

- Finance curriculum (financial markets, banking and risk management)
- Industrial Organization and Market Strategies (theoretical and empirical industrial organization, regulatory economics and competition policy)
- International Integration curriculum (international cooperation, economic development and international economic problems and architecture)

ELIGIBILITY

- Students must hold a Bachelor's degree in Economics/Management/similar disciplines
- Students who have validated the equivalent of 180 ECTS credits
- Students who are enrolled in a Master's program in their home university

LANGUAGE OF INSTRUCTION

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

All requirements set out by the two universities must be fulfilled:

- 120 ECTS credits (60 ECTS credits in each university)
